The weather was perfect for an outdoor showing, the place was packed (upwards to 600 people) and MANY responded to the good news! New Tribes Missions with the Lolo people group in Mozambique: Matt, Debi, Melody, William and Nicholas Zook: We are back in Mozambique since the end of April. The flights went great from Perth to Johannesburg to Nampula. Traveling with four children was not a drama as they slept a lot and were well behaved. When we arrived home, we found everything in generally good repair. The first day back was Sunday and we met with believers from our village for church. It was good to see them and they were glad to see us. One of the teachers had caused all manner of problems in our absence and is no longer a part of the body but thankfully other believers from nearby stepped

up and kept things going. The first week back was mostly unpacking and having visitors come and visit us. We got given enough peanuts and corn flour to keep us going for a while. The children adjusted really well. William in particular had refused to speak any Lolo while in America and Australia and had badly forgotten the language, but he has been playing with his buddies and is speaking great again. Matt has gone on a couple survey trips as we are planning to extend our work towards the northwest. There are some many Lolo speakers and so great needs that it is overwhelming at times. Of the 36 interviews of church leaders that we conducted, only 3 mentioned Christ as having a part in forgiveness of sins. To the rest, Christianity is summed up by following the law, not drinking alcohol, not having 2 or more wives, et. PRAY THAT GOD WOULD GIVE US WISDOM IN TO HOW TO BEST PROCLAIM THE EXCELLENCIES OF HIS NAME. We did a consultant check of the books of Malachi and Daniel so that it can be added to the Lolo scriptures to be printed. We also are concluding a review of the proofs we received from the type setters. PRAY THAT GOD WILL GIVE US EYES TO SEE ANYTHING ELSE THAT MIGHT NEED CHANGED. We have also been teaching some transitional literacy classes in preparation for the arrival of the Bible in the Lolo language.

New Tribes Missions in Lusi Tribe, Papua New Guinea: Rick, Anji, Kira and Keane Zook. Pray for our team's health and safety. We're a long way from medical help where we live in the bush, so we don't take this lightly. God is the great healer and He is certainly capable of healing us. One of our coworkers is still recovering from an illness he had this spring, it has been a very slow recovery. Mosquito borne diseases just come the territory. Rick has been struggling with a hurt back, which seems to be improving. As far as safety goes, we are currently in the midst of election season, which has its ups and downs. But we feel pretty safe in the village, as relationships are a safety net. However, this is the "Land of the Unexpected", and the unexpected does sometimes happen. We do covet your prayers for our safety. No matter what happens, or where we are, we know that God is in control. Pray for our team. Kevin and Rose have returned from their Home Assignment time, so now everyone on the team is here. Pray for our team relationships, that we would be an example of the unity that there is in Christ. Pray that we would think more highly of others than ourselves, and that we would show love to others in all that we do. Pray for our team, our Mouk coworkers and their wives and children, that their relationships would be healthy, and that they would demonstrate what love is, for a people who don't have a word for it in their language.
